

# ○ Trans-Femoral Post-Op Dressing Retention Sock

The primary goal in post-operative care following a trans-femoral amputation is to maintain the position of the soft dressing. The **Dressing Retention Sock** provides a very soft, gently-compressive fit with a belt suspension.

The sock can be applied immediately post-operative in the recovery room, or within the first few days following surgery. A shrinker can be applied after staples have been removed and the added compression can be tolerated.
